

# Workshops on Green Energy& Circular Economy- How Business and Electric Vehicles Run on 100% Renewable Energies Hold by ECCT LCI, PwC and TPRI of Taipower

In response to the global carbon reduction trend, TPRI of Taipower organized the “How Business and Electric Vehicles Run on 100% Renewable Energies” with European Chamber of Commerce Taiwan (ECCT) Low Carbon Initiative (LCI) and PwC in the afternoon on September 1, 2022. The meeting was co-chaired by Dr. Chung, General Manager of TPRI, TPC, Tsai Yi-tai, Partner at PwC Taiwan, and Giuseppe Izzo, Chair of ECCT LCI Steering Committee. The participants include the ECCT LCI & PwC members and departments from TPC, in a total of 153 people participated in this online workshop. RWE Renewables, Hitachi Energy, Metrology and Inspection, MOEA, and Taipei 101 were invited to share their experience of how the international energy

industry assists the industry in the transition of the energy supply chain. Discussed topics include “Renewable energy supply chain”, “Sustainability Strategy 2030 and VPP & microgrid solutions for renewable energy integration”, “Green leasing: New solutions for energy procurement in commercial buildings”, and “Renewable energy certificate”. These experiences shared in this meeting can be used as a reference for Taiwan Power Company to organize our development strategies for 100% Renewable Energy in the future. The next following workshop will be held in December 2022 focusing on off-shore wind farms. TPRI will continuously and truly stay on top of international trends in energy development.
